5. What are your thoughts about Liv and how she reacts to the possibility of Thea and Gavin reuniting?
6. How does WAG play a role in Thea and Gavin's relationship? Are there similar influences in real life?
7. How do Ava and Olivia move the story? Do you think Thea and Gavin would have tried as hard to reconcile without them?
8. Is Gavin's stutter important to the story? Why or why not? If not, why do you think it is included?
9. Would you want to be wooed by someone learning romance lessons from a Regency romance novel? Why or why not?
